


Martock Village Walk 1 Mile Grading Accessible

This walk begins at the Library; Moorlands Park car park (TA12 6DH) is adjacent with some accessible parking spaces. There are toilet facilities at the Library. It is very much a pavement walk starting at North Street. Most of the walk is through residential areas. There is also a footpath around the 13th century Martock Church (grade1 listed).



1. From the Library turn left after less than 50 yards, down the path next to the convenience shop. At the end of the path bear left joining East St then take the next road turning left signposted as Foldhill lane.
2. Take next left to Moorlands Park. Take the first right and then keep straight, through Moorlands Close. At the end of the T junction, cross over onto the path with a staggered barrier at both ends. At the end of this path, cross over and enter the road signposted Rope Walk, slightly on your left.
3. At the T junction turn bare right at the end of the close onto the path between the housing. At the end of the path turn left and follow the track onto the pavement along Steps Crescent, until you get to the mini roundabout. At the mini roundabout, turn right on Steps Meadow
4. After about 200 yards, take the first road on your left. Follow the road to the end where you will meet North Street, the main street running through

Martock. Turn right and cross the road, taking the first left into Old Market Road. After 100 yards, Turn left onto the road signposted Fairfield.

5. Keep left at the cul de sac along the path and at the end, turn right onto the path and follow it alongside the playing field.
6. At the end of the playing field, go through the gate and turn left onto the track, which is known as Hills Lane (**Note: this lane can become muddy, especially in winter**). Take a right on the first path, shortly before the track meets North Street, up a slight incline. Follow the path to the end and then bear left on Birch Road.
7. At the end of Birch Road there are 2 options
 1. Is a shorter option: turn left at the T junction and cross at the end of the road using the Zebra crossing. Turn right down North Street, and back to the carpark/library.
 2. Is a slightly longer option: turn right at the T junction, and then take the second left, signposted Ashfield Park. Bear left following the road all the way round. After Church close, ensure you are on the right side of the road before reaching the close on your left, where there is a high kerb. At the end of the road, cross over to the row of shops and turn left back to the carpark/library.

Keep straight across the next cul de sac along the path then turn left and then right along another pathway. At the road turn right then take a left into Ashfield Park. Continue along Ashfield park to North Street back to the library.
